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The Leadership for Collective Intelligence (LCI) Program is an intensive 10-month learning and development experience that will both challenge you and provide you with a powerful approach to enable you to bring about significant, transformative change in yourself and your organization.

The LCI requires a serious commitment of time and attention. Unlike some development programs, each of the 4-day sessions is designed as a whole, and therefore require full attendance at every session. Because the LCI is an "action learning" process, you will be asked to apply the learning you gain off-site in the practical day-to-day problems of your organization, to reflect on what you have learned and to bring those reflections back to the course. We also endeavor to insure that every LCI class has the right mix of diverse, accomplished, and thoughtful individuals from a wide variety of organizations. For these reasons we ask that you complete this application thoughtfully and completely, so that we have a clear sense of your interest and commitment. *Please provide us with each the following. You may attach pages to this form. (Your application is not considered complete until we have received each of these items):*

1. Statement of Intention

Please write a one-page statement outlining why you want to attend the LCI, and what your specific intentions are in coming. You may express this in any way that you wish. We are interested in what areas you would like to develop in yourself as a leader, the kinds of skills or capabilities you would like to have, the nature and level of the challenges you would like to be able to master, and your long term professional aspirations: what do you dream you could do?

2. Personal Background

Please tell us about yourself, in at least one and no more than three pages. Some options for what you might write about include, but are not limited to: your background and personal story, a significant career challenge you have had, a dilemma or risk you have taken, a leader who significantly influenced you, or the way you approached a significant business or organizational problem.

3. Leadership Story

In no more than a page, please describe the time when you first experienced yourself as a leader. This can be from any moment in your life, and be drawn from personal, educational, or work experience. It need not be about a "large" event or situation, or something others acknowledged.

4. Champion's Letter of Recommendation

Please submit a letter of recommendation from a superior who is also prepared to act as a support and sounding board for you while attending the LCI.

5. A Recent Photograph

Please attach a recent photograph to your application (Scanned images are fine).
